Two Year Pharmacy Residency in Informatics/Technology July 2010-June 2012

Cedars-Sinai Medical Center is a 960-bed acute, tertiary care teaching hospital located in the heart of Los Angeles, just a block away from Beverly Hills. The Department of Pharmacy Services consists of over 300 staff members and provides decentralized pharmacy services to patients via six satellite pharmacies and three outpatient pharmacies in the following subspecialty areas:

The Department of Pharmacy Services is offering a two year Residency in Pharmacy Informatics/Technology. The goal of this residency is to provide the resident with one year of postgraduate advanced training in emerging technologies and health information systems, with an emphasis on clinical applications and impact on patient care. This residency will develop pharmacy practitioners with working knowledge of health information systems and integration into clinical practice, as well as project management experience, along with research in informatics. Experience in the assessment of these systems impact on patient care and clinician workflow will also be developed.

The Department of Pharmacy Services will provide the resident experience including but not limited to:

- ◆ Integrated Clinical Information System, Including Pharmacy IS, Electronic MAR, CPOE
- ◆ Decentralized Automated Dispensing Units
- ◆ Carousel Inventory System
- ◆ Automated Patient Identification System for Bedside Medication Administration
- ◆ Central Robot for Cart Fill
- ◆ Smart Infusion Pumps
- ◆ Automated Dispensing Cabinets

The resident will work with a multidisciplinary team and have the opportunity to be involved in Project Management, Teaching and Didactic Training.

Residency Projects

The resident will be involved in multiple projects throughout the year and will have the opportunity to present a longitudinal project at the Western States Conference.

Requirements

The applicant must be a graduate of an accredited School of Pharmacy with a Doctor of Pharmacy degree. Candidates must be eligible for licensure in California and resident is expected to be licensed by September of the residency year.

Benefits

Benefits include 26 days of paid time off, 10 of which are used for educational leave, as well as medical and dental insurance.

Application

Motivated individuals with initiative and a commitment to excellence are encouraged to apply. Additionally, successful applicants should possess superior verbal and written communication skills. Interested applicants should provide a curriculum vitae, three letters of reference, transcripts, and a letter of intent.
