

WOMEN'S HEALTH RESEARCH REGISTRY

Women have traditionally been excluded from medical research studies. Researchers often assumed that findings involving men would equitably translate into a correct assessment for women as well. As we learn more, we find that medicines and treatments that work fine in men sometimes work differently in women. Cedars-Sinai Medical Center offers many services for women, and a major component of our commitment to maintaining excellence in patient care is biomedical research.

Cedars-Sinai ranks among the top 10 non-university hospitals nationwide receiving research funding from the National Institutes of Health. In addition, Cedars-Sinai is currently conducting more than 600 research projects through the Burns & Allen Research Institute. These projects encompass basic, clinical and health services research and cover the entire spectrum of disease investigation, including molecular genetics, biochemical analysis, comparative animal research and clinical studies.

Improving the Future of Women's Health

As part of our commitment to women's health, the Women's Health Resource Center at Cedars-Sinai has established the Women's Health Research Registry (a database that contains health information shared by interested women who want to make a

contribution to the future of medicine). As we begin clinical trials at Cedars-Sinai, we contact appropriate candidates in the registry to see if they would like to participate.
